2014-2015 GRADES 3-5 POETRY CONTEST

GUIDELINES

- Poems must be *original* creations reflecting the thoughts, ideas, and/or musings of ACPS students in grades 3-5 during the 2014-2015 school year. Please talk to students about plagiarism.
- Only one poem per student may be submitted.
- Any form of poetry may be submitted; there is no specific theme, but each
 poem must have a title (The title Untitled is an acceptable title).
- Only one side of one page may be used.
- All poems must be typed and submitted electronically.
- The student's name, grade, teacher, and school (in this order please)
 need to be typed on the poem, <u>centered at bottom</u>. Please refrain
 from including graphics.
- Poems shall be judged at the school level by at least two different teachers using the ACPS Poetry Contest Criteria Checklist.
- Each elementary school will select one poem as the school winner and a winning poem for each grade, (3, 4, and 5); four poems total.
- Please do not announce winning poems and/or the student authors until poems are verified by Anne Booth and Suzanne Lank. Each previous year, at least one poem submitted as "original," was later found to be on the web or in a book. Dr. Booth will send a permission slip/release for the winning poems once they are verified.
- Selected poems should be sent electronically to Anne Booth anne.booth@acps.k12.va.us any time prior to but not later than June 11, 2014 @ 5:00 p.m.
- Poems submitted by schools will be judged by the Elementary Poet
 Laureate Selection Committee, which will select one division winner (to be
 named as the Elementary Poet Laureate) and three grade-level winners
 (to be named Exemplary Poets).

The 13 school-level winners, the three division winners (Exemplary Poets) for grades 3-5, and the Elementary Poet Laureate will receive invitations to the Poetry Celebration and reception on June 17, 2015.

Due to space and time limitations, schools' grade-level winners cannot be recognized at the Poetry Celebration. Dr. Booth will send each school's grade-level winners a certificate and a copy of this year's anthology before the close of the school year.
